Sleeping car Service includes complimentary meals, morning wake-up service with a newspaper, and coffee, tea and orange juice served between 6:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. ClubAcela® lounges are available in New York, Philadelphia and Washington, and private waiting area available in Miami and Raleigh, for Sleeping car Service passengers.
-  **Dining:** Full meal service appropriate to time of day.
-  **Lounge:** Sandwiches, snacks and beverages.

Bicycles: Trains are equipped with a limited number of bike racks for carrying unboxed bicycles.

-  **Lounge:** Sandwiches, snacks and beverages.
- Trails and Rails Program:** In a cooperative effort with the National Park Service, an interpretive guide from the Martin Luther King Jr. National Historic Site provides a narrative between Atlanta and New Orleans from Memorial Day to Mid-August. Seasonal program and schedules subject to change.

Thruway Motorcoach Connections

Thruway connections provide coordinated train/motorcoach service with connections at the Amtrak station (in most cases), as well as through fares and ticketing. Passengers traveling on Thruway connections must be ticketed before boarding coaches in order to obtain through fares. Except for the South Carolina connections above, motorcoaches are normally not accessible to passengers who use wheelchairs; however, wheelchair-accessible van is available between Orlando/Tampa and Pinellas/St. Petersburg, Bradenton, Sarasota, Port Charlotte and Fort Myers with 48 hours advance notice.

The following interline services are available to locations not served by Amtrak. Contact the individual carrier listed for further information.

Newark Liberty International Airport

Frequent Airliner bus service operates between Amtrak's Newark Station and Newark Airport. Purchase ticket from bus driver; www.njtransit.com.

Philadelphia Center City

SEPTA operates frequent rail service between Philadelphia 30th Street Station and Center City (Penn Center/Suburban Station and Market East Station). Amtrak tickets to or from Philadelphia are honored between 30th Street and Center City; www.septa.com.

Philadelphia International Airport

SEPTA operates commuter rail service every 30 minutes between the upper level of 30th Street Station and Terminals A, B, C, D, E at Philadelphia Airport. Purchase tickets at SEPTA ticket office or vending machine. SEPTA (215) 580-7800; www.septa.com.

Raleigh Transit Connection

Capital Area Transit (CAT) provides service between the Amtrak station in Raleigh and the Moore Square Transit Station at 221 S. Wilmington St., daily except Sundays and holidays. Moore Square Station serves CAT routes throughout the Raleigh area. Pay fare to driver. (919) 828-7228; www.raleigh-nc.org/transit.

☑ **Sleeping cars:** Superliner sleeping accommodations.

☑ **Dining:** Complimentary sit-down dinner with wine and continental breakfast.

☑ **Lounge:** Snacks and beverages.

☑ **Entertainment:** Feature movies in lounge.

Baggage: Auto Train does not offer checked baggage service. Passengers may carry an overnight bag on board—include any medications. All other baggage should be packed inside your vehicle. We suggest that you lock valuable items in the trunk of your car or in the glove compartment and retain the key. Passengers do not have access to their vehicles while they are on the train.

Smoking: Cigarette smoking is permitted in an enclosed room on the lower level of the lounge cars. No smoking in sleeping cars, coaches or dining cars.



Requirements

Only passengers with automobiles (including vans) or motorcycles may travel on Auto Train.

- Autos must have 4 in. (10 cm) ground clearance. Vehicles exceeding 65 in. (165 cm) in height and 182 in. (4.62 m) in length must reserve oversized vehicle space. Vehicles with low ground clearance, which include those with custom or low profile wheels, may be refused.
- Oversized vehicles can also be accommodated. Maximum height allowable for oversized vehicles is 88 in. (2.23 m). Maximum width from outside edge of tire to outside edge of opposite tire is 84 in.
- A limited number of spaces are also available to carry small enclosed trailers, or trailers for transporting boats, jet skis, motorcycles, etc. Call Amtrak for details.
- We can carry vehicles with luggage packed on the roof in factory-installed racks if they are within the specified height limit. Call Amtrak for details.
- A limited number of spaces are also available to transport motorcycles. Only standard, two-wheel motorcycles can be accepted. All motorcycles must have at least 5 in. (13 cm) clearance between the lowest portion of the frame and the bottom of the tires. Motorcycles with windshields cannot exceed 57.5 in. (1.46 m) in height. We cannot carry motorcycles with side cars, extended forks, ape hanger handlebars, or chopper-style bikes. Passengers must assist in securing and removing their motorcycles.
- Animals are not allowed aboard Auto Train except for trained service animals accompanying passengers with disabilities. Animals are not allowed to remain in passengers' vehicles.
